Junior JA Finance Park Please read slide to students. There are various types of Investments. Here are a few listed from safest to riskiest: Savings Bank Account / CD Stocks Click for next slide. Disperse one slip of paper to each Junior Achievement JA Finance Park student. (red, yellow, green) Ask students to read slips of paper to see how risky their investments are. You will be investing \$1000 for a period of 5 year. Hand a die to each student. Have them roll the die and keep the number that comes up. Click for next slide. Junior Achievement JA Finance Park If you have a green slip and rolled a What number did you roll? 1,3,4,5 or 6, you made money, \$1050 over 5 years! Green: 1,3,4,5,6 Return after 5 years - \$1050 Click for next slide. Junior Achievement JA Finance Park* If you have a yellow slip and rolled a 2, 4 or 6, you made money, \$1280 What number did you roll? over 5 years! Return after 5 years - \$1280 Click for next slide.

If you have a red slip, you only made money if you rolled a 1 or a 3!! But you made \$1645 over 5 years.

If you rolled any other numbers, you may have lost money.

Point out the code that they need to unlock Savings.

After each group leaves, return to the first slide for the next group.

Display this slide during Shopping and Payment. For Retirement Fund, the two buckets must add to 100%. For Emergency & Other Savings, the two buckets must add to 100% also.
